2. Thank God for Walnut Hill Baptist Church as they joined my partnership team, and pray that God will lead more

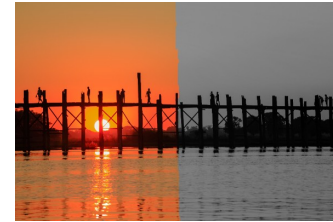
