Does this book really exist in my language?" She gave him a copy, and "as Ibrahim reached out to accept the book, his broad smile gave way to an expression of amazement. He thanked me profusely. Leaving the rest of his tea, he walked away distractedly, already leafing through the book and scanning each page.

The next morning as I opened my curtains, I spotted him sitting in a chair engrossed in his New Testament. He must have read for a good portion of the night, because I could see that he was already more than halfway through it.
